



## Project STEEEP

EUROCHAMBRES and 35 Chambers of Commerce and Industry (CCIs) from 10 different European countries will provide 630 cross-sector SMEs with tailored training and guidance on effective energy management tools and practices targeted towards specific national or regional needs. This will enable SMEs to measure and consequently control energy costs more efficiently.

STEEEP will make use of the experience CCIs gained from previous projects and will deliver their actions mainly through SME workshops, bilateral coaching and help desks. The consortium ensures a wide geographic coverage and a mix between established and developing intelligent energy advisors, who will exchange their experience through comprehensive training and regular cross-border learning network meetings.

Moreover, an experienced academic partner will scientifically evaluate the potential for energy savings, set efficiency targets, and monitor progress in implementing measures to reduce energy consumption.

Additionally, pilot projects will be implemented in seven different countries across Europe, involving additional SMEs and setting up Local Energy Communities, shifting energy management from an individual approach to a collective one.
